- Treasurer report was read, motion to accept and seconded and all approved.
- Executive Assistant reported we had 123 members.

- Reflections Newsletter to go to press June 22. Summer Edition; WCHA sold 26 books since the last meeting for a remaining total at 18 Heritage, 695 Glimpses, 2030, P. C., 144 inventory and 5 History of Wayne County.
- Waynesborough: Velda Faye Howell will have a Friends Meeting Sabbath For Children @ 2:00p m, July 7, 2001 @ the Bethany Friends Meeting House.
- No report from Old Dobbs: Meeting July 28 @ the Western Sizzlen @ 11:30am.
- Revolving Fund: Charles Gaylor said he would like everyone to go to 403 W Mulberry St. after the next meeting. We have to do some work with this house and there is no money. We also have 2 houses to sell on S. Virginia St.
- Charles B. Aycock BP: Charlotte Brown said there will be a day camp for 3 days for ages, 8-12, July 23, 24, and 25 from 9AM till Noon. Cost is \$5.00. Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> Century School, Tuesday, learning about farm life and domestic chores will be the plan for Wed. Reservations are required.

- Wayne County Museum: Coin Show & Sale, July 14, Sat. 8-5pm 10'X10' spaces or tables for \$25.00 each. \$2:00 admission.
- Fremont Historical Society: Jimmy Ballence said their 1<sup>st</sup> annual spring meeting was June 2<sup>nd</sup> @ C. B. Aycock BP, they had a Pig-picking after a business meeting. The Society and Fremont Boy Scouts placed small American Flags at the graves of Armed Forces Veterans in the two Fremont Cemeteries.
